

I am an experienced Consultant Neurophysiologist and have been preparing detailed medico legal reports since 2009. Nerve conduction and EMG studies are commonly requested in personal injury claims to map out the extent of nerve/muscle/spinal cord damage and to offer a prognosis for the patient. The results of these tests often lead to crucial surgical decisions. I prepare around 50 medico legal reports each year for personal injury cases. Most of my work has been for the claimant, given the nature of my specialty. Since 2019 I have been preparing medical negligence claim reports, most of which are also for claimants with perhaps around 10% being for defendants. In all cases, I endeavour to write as unbiased a report as possible. In recent years, I have also had several medico legal requests for undertaking electroencephalograms (EEG's) in victims of head injury.

I am an OSCE examiner for Liverpool University School of Medicine and ex Senior Lecturer for Edge Hill University. I held a substantive Consultant post at the Walton Centre Foundation Trust but am now in fulltime private practice.
